Smoke Detector Program to Save Lives

The Pleasant Hill Volunteer Fire Department is offering free smoke detectors and batteries to the residents of West Manheim Township. This program was started about 2 years ago with the American Red Cross and ABC 27 news. We are doing an update for our area and due to the upcoming Holidays and to have the opportunity to interact with the community.

To obtain a free smoke detector or batteries please call the Pleasant Hill Fire Department at (717)637-7778 during the business hours, Monday through Friday, 8am to 6pm. If no answer leave a message for Chad Grimes and he will get back you to as soon as possible.

The Pleasant Hill Fire Department would recommend the following for the residents:

- *Remember to check the batteries in your smoke alarm. Smoke alarm batteries need to be change about twice a year.
- * Once you have changed the batteries make sure you test the alarm at least once on a monthly basis.
- *Install at least one smoke alarm on every level of your home, outside of every room that's used for sleeping purpose and inside every room that's used for sleeping purpose.
- *Keep smoke alarms clean by vacuuming over and around them on a regularly basis.
- *As with any appliance, smoke alarm wear out. As a recommendation of the manufacturer to replaced the entire smoke alarm every 10 years.
- *Organize and practice a family fire drill.
- *Make sure you know where the local fire department, police and hospital numbers are. Place a list of them by your telephone in case of an emergency.
